<u>July</u>

TODAYIn our last study of Matthew 5:8 we learned that when Christ becomes ours and we become His through the bond of faith, we receive three wonderful gifts: 1. <u>Justification</u>, which is legal (in Christ God drops all charges against us), 2. <u>Forgiveness</u>, which is relational (in Christ God reconciles us to Himself), 3. <u>Cleansing</u>, which is personal (in Christ God cleanses our hearts and lives and makes us a new creature).

This sixth Beatitude is about cleansing. It's about God taking the baggage of our lives—the effects of what we have thought and loved and done—and cleansing our minds and our hearts. It's about God dealing with our twisted patterns of thinking, our misdirected patterns of loving and our compulsive patterns of behaving. Today we come to the all-important question: How can I cultivate a pure heart? Better yet, how can I want to cultivate a pure heart?
