AUGUST

TODAYWe come to the last of our Lord's seven-fold description of Christian character. The peace of which Christ speaks in this beatitude has nothing to do with this world or its system. God's peace has nothing to do with politics, armies, compromise, truces, or treaties. The peace about which Jesus speaks is more than the absence of conflict and strife; it is the presence of righteousness. Only righteousness can produce the relationship that brings two parties together. Men can stop fighting without righteousness, but they cannot live peaceably without righteousness. Righteousness not only puts an end to harm, but it administers the healing of **love or commitment.** James confirms the nature of God's peace when he writes, "But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable" (James 3:17). As I've indicated before, there is a natural progression to each of these Kingdom attributes and here is another example. God's way to peace is through purity. Last week we talked of being "pure in heart," which is the bridge we must cross in order to find peace. Peace of heart flows from purity of life.
