"FINDING JOY IN TIMES OF PERSECUTION. Pt. 2" Matthew 5:10-12

TODAYJesus says that everyone who does wicked things "hates the light" (John 3:20). They love darkness because they think it shrouds their evil. If the light is in you, expect to be hated.

If you grow in Christ as He expects, the light of Christ shines from within you. A sinner has to suppress his own conscience to sustain what he's doing. A godly colleague or neighbor brings the light that sinners are trying to avoid.

So, don't expect to be thanked for living a godly life at work, with unsaved family or neighbors. Sinners will be suspicious of you for living a godly life—at best, and hostile towards you for living a godly life—at worst.

This morning we will look the pattern of persecution, the forms in which it comes, and the blessing and rewards that come with it.
