

TODAYWe learned at the outset of our study, that the most critical verse in our text is found in verse 21 where it says, "submit to one another out of reverence for Christ."

Yes, God has ordained that in each institution He created, the HOME, GOVERNMENT, EMPLOYMENT & CHURCH, there should be an authority structure. But for any institution to be truly successful, it must be founded on relationships that are successful. And for any relationship to be truly successful, it must involve people submitted to God and who in turn manifest that submission to God by submitting to others.
