We believe that Communion should be open to any Christian, guest or church member, who shows proper appreciation for the significance of the body and blood of Christ and who is not living in willful disobedience to God (1 Corinthians 11:27-30). As the communion trays are passed, we invite you to partake of the bread before passing the tray on. Then when receiving the cup, partake of its contents and place the empty cup back in the tray.

TODAY.... On the night before His death and after washing the disciples feet, our Lord introduced a second and final ordinance for the church known as Communion or the Eucharist (giving thanks) or The Lord's Supper.

In this meal with His disciples, Jesus took the cup and the loaf—*ingredients of a common meal in that day*—and transformed them into a meaningful, spiritual experience not just for them but for all believers.

Because we eat at this table each week, it is easy to become casual in our approach to this sacred ordinance or to overlook or get used to it as a focal point of our worship. The Lord's Table should never be that to us. We must guard against it becoming just another part of our Sunday agenda. This morning we look at the reasons for us to be careful with our attitude and look at Four directions we each must look before taking part.
