TODAY ... We said last week, the book of Ruth is not just about how to find fulfillment in **difficult** times, but also about how to find fulfillment in **single** times. Ruth is likely the only book in the bible where all the main characters are single. Naomi, Ruth, Orpah, Boaz, all of them were either single or single again. It is important to note that no matter the current attitude of culture, no matter what you might believe about singleness, according to 1 Corinthians 7, it is the most excellent way. Not that marriage is somehow morally inferior to singleness. It is not. But the encouragement of Scripture is clear, consider singleness first. It has a high place with God and should be honored and never discredited. Singles have a rare opportunity to do what those who are married cannot. Regardless, if God has given you the **opportunity** to be single or single again or married, I know "**Ruth's Guidelines for Singles**" will encourage you to approach your calling with sincerity and clarity.
